

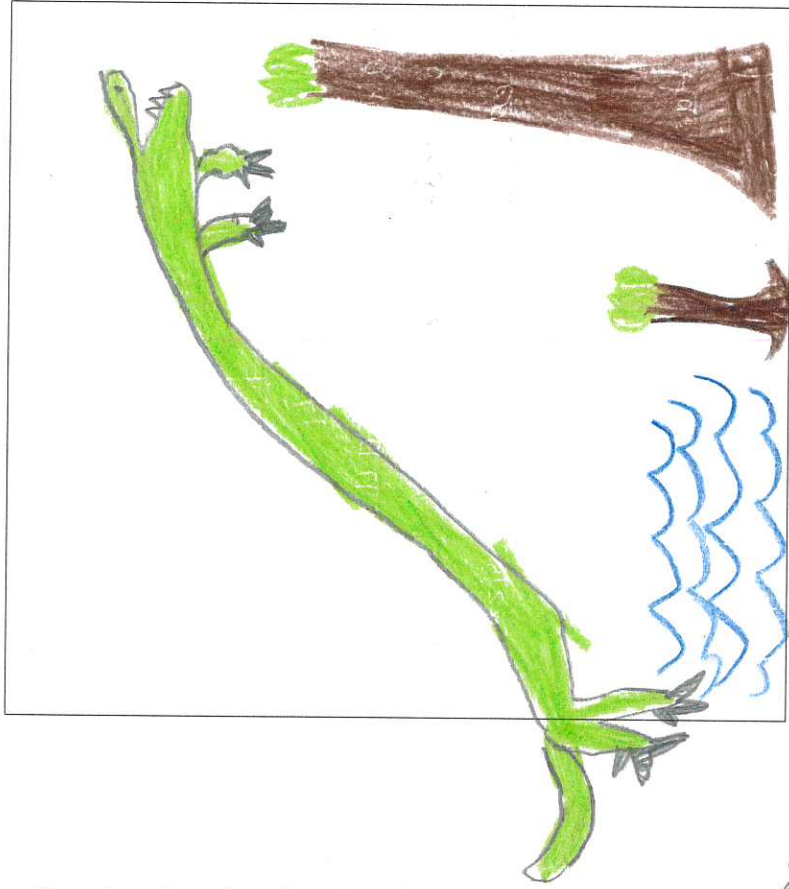
Introduction
